In such challenging circumstances, possessing essential knowledge and skills becomes paramount to safeguarding the well-being of both mothers and babies, thereby mitigating potential human losses.

General objective: The objective of this two-hour online seminar is to share fundamental knowledge and practical skills essential for facilitating safe childbirth in disaster scenarios. Tailored for sanitary workers deployed in the field and individuals keen on preemptive preparedness, this event seeks to provide a foundation in identifying, preventing, and managing childbirth-related events amidst crisis situations. By the end of the workshop, participants will have new important information about childbirth emergencies, and a better notion of how to ensure the safety and well-being of both mothers and infants in the midst of disaster scenarios.
